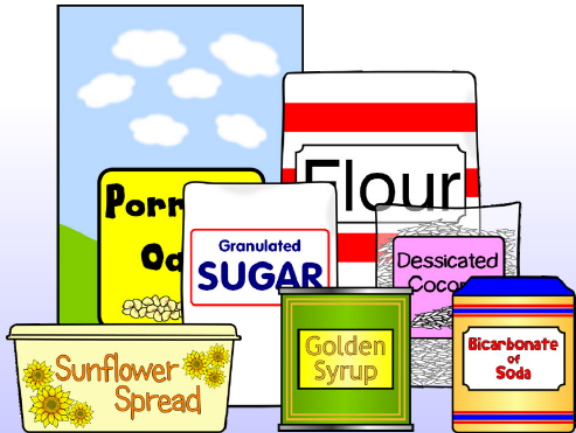




A Recipe for Anzac Biscuits

Ingredients:

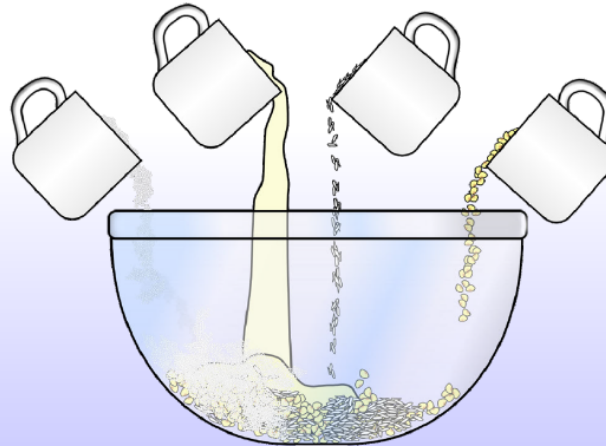
- 1 cup rolled oats
- 1 cup plain flour
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup desiccated coconut
- 125g butter
- 2 tbsp golden syrup
- 2 tbsp water
- 1 tsp bicarbonate of soda

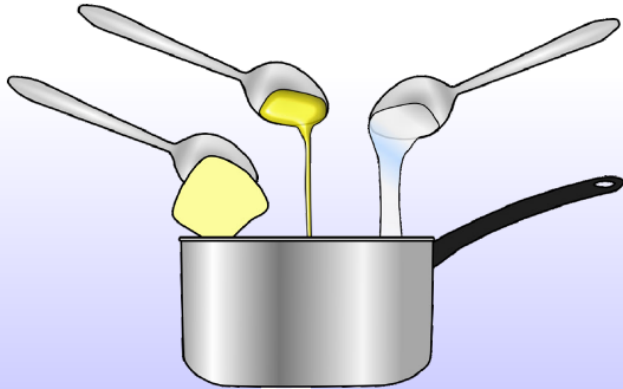
Mix together the oats, flour, sugar and coconut in a bowl.

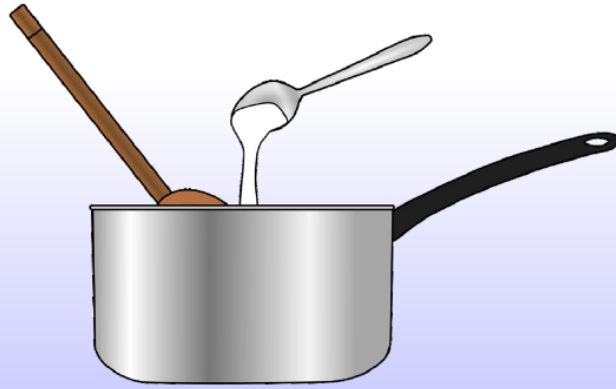
Mix the butter, golden syrup and water in a saucepan over a medium heat.

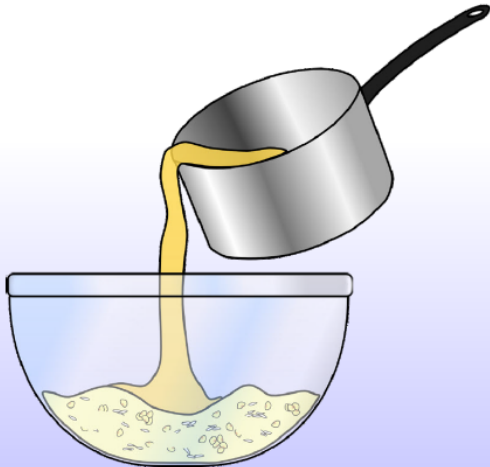
Once the butter has melted, stir in the bicarbonate of soda.

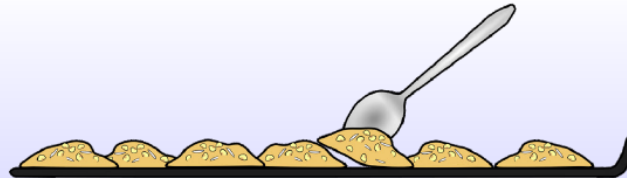
Pour the heated mixture into the bowl with the dry ingredients and mix well.

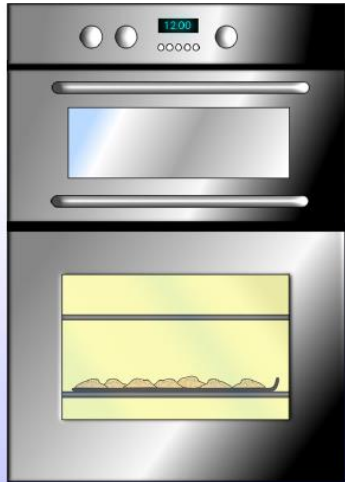
Put teaspoons of the mixture onto a greased oven tray or a tray lined with oven paper.

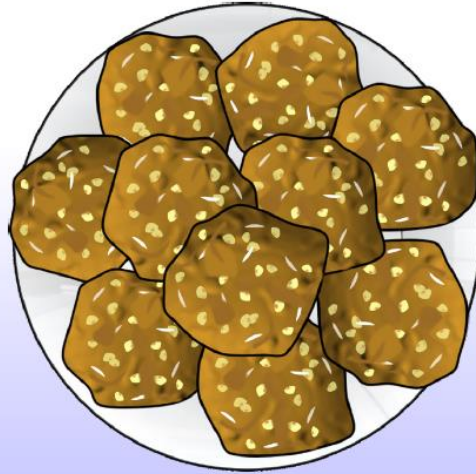
Cook in a preheated oven at 180°C/Gas Mark 4 for about 15 minutes.

Simpson and his Donkey



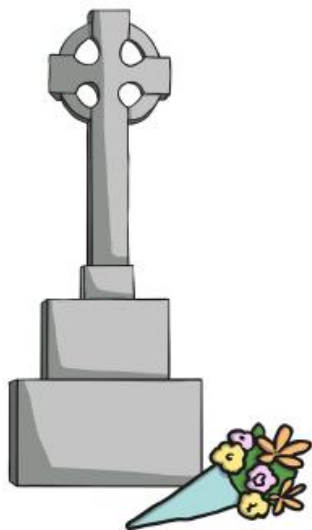
Jack Simpson was an Australian soldier.
His job was to carry wounded men on
stretchers to safety. One day, Jack passed
a donkey and had a great idea.



It took at least two men to carry an injured man on a stretcher, but with the help of a donkey Simpson could easily carry a man on his own. Stretcher teams could make six trips to rescue soldiers in one day, but with a donkey Simpson could make twice as many trips.



Jack would put the injured man on the donkey's back and walk the man to safety. The paths Jack took were very dangerous with bullets flying all over the place. Simpson wasn't scared. Soldiers were amazed at how hard Jack worked to rescue so many men in such dangerous conditions.



Sadly, one day while helping an injured soldier down the valley on one of his donkeys, Jack was shot and killed.

It was a very sad day for the ANZACs as many of them had seen how bravely Jack had worked.
